

End User License Agreement (EULA)

This is a legal agreement between you, the company or other organisation that you represent ("The Licensee") and DesignBase trading as Subject2Light ("DesignBase").

Please read this agreement carefully in its entirety before downloading or using any image. In downloading, using or confirming the purchase of the Image(s) you have selected from the website or by any other method The Licensee agrees to be bound by the terms & conditions ("Terms") of this EULA (the "Agreement") and the Image usage restrictions contained herein.

1. Definitions

- 1.1. "Invoice" means the printed or computer-generated invoice provided by DesignBase that may include, without limitation, the permitted scope of use of the Image(s) selected, any limitations on the license in addition to those specified herein and the corresponding price for the license. The Terms contained in the Invoice shall be incorporated into this Agreement and all references to the Agreement shall include those Terms.
- 1.2. "Image(s)" means the image(s) or CD collection of images as identified on the invoice.
- 1.3. "License" means the non-exclusive (unless otherwise stated in the invoice) non-transferable non-sublicensable right DesignBase grants to The Licensee to use the Image(s).
- 1.4. "License Fee" means any sum or sums payable to DesignBase by The Licensee in respect of the License.
- 1.5. "Reproduced" / "Reproduction" means any form of copying or publication of the whole or a part of any Image via any medium and by whatever means including; printing, electronic, digital or mechanical transfer, display or use as a reference by an artist or by any other means and the distortion or manipulation of the whole or any part of the Image and the creation of any derivative work from the Image.

2. Grant of rights and restrictions

- 2.1. DesignBase grants to The Licensee perpetual worldwide non-exclusive (unless otherwise stated in the invoice) non-transferable non-sublicensable right to Reproduce the Image(s) solely for the following purposes:
 - advertising and promotional materials;
 - broadcast and theatrical exhibition;
 - any electronic publications to a maximum resolution of 72dpi subject to clauses 2.5;
 - any printed products or publications subject to clauses 2.5;
 - any other use agreed in writing by DesignBase.
- 2.2. The Licensee may alter, crop, manipulate and create derivative works from the Image(s).
- 2.3. The Licensee must not incorporate Images (or any part of them) into a logo or trade mark.
- 2.4. One copy of the Image(s) may be stored in a digital image library (including that on a network configuration) provided that the Subject2Light Image reference number is retained. One further copy may be stored for backup purposes only.
- 2.5. The Image(s) may not be sublicensed, resold or otherwise made available for download, use or distribution separately including, without limitation, the printing of postcards for resale or used as part of a design template intended for resale unless otherwise agreed in writing with DesignBase. The Licensee may include an Image as part of a derivative work (for example an advertisement or website) for its own clients but should any of The Licensee's clients wish to incorporate the Image in their own or other sub-contracted work they must purchase an additional license from DesignBase.
- 2.6. The Licensee may not use the Image(s) in a pornographic, defamatory, fraudulent, lewd, obscene or otherwise illegal manner, including without limitation infringing any third party intellectual property or privacy rights, whether directly or in context or juxtaposition with other materials.
- 2.7. The Licensee must abide by any restriction on use notified by DesignBase before, after or at the time of delivery of the Image(s), either in the information accompanying the Image(s), the Invoice or otherwise.
- 2.8. DesignBase or their appointed representatives, after reasonable notice, may inspect any records, accounts and books relating to the Reproduction of any of the Image(s) to ensure that the Image(s) are being used in accordance with this Agreement.

3. Copyright

- 3.1. No ownership or copyright in any Image shall pass to The Licensee by the issue of the License.
- 3.2. Unless otherwise agreed in writing, if any Image is Reproduced by The Licensee for editorial purposes (i.e., for any non-promotional purpose) the credit line "Julie Harris/Subject2Light", or any other credit line specified on the invoice must be included in the Reproduction. If a credit line is omitted then an additional fee equal (100%) to the original License Fee, shall be payable at DesignBase's discretion.
- 3.3. Use of an Image in a manner not specifically authorised under the Terms set out in the Invoice or otherwise in this Agreement constitutes a breach of the Agreement and an infringement of copyright.

4. Releases

- 4.1. Where a model release and/or a property release for an Image has been obtained The Licensee will be notified by the Subject2Light website, Invoice or other means. If no such notification is given then no such model or property release has been obtained. Except where The Licensee is specifically notified, DesignBase grants no rights and makes no warranties with regard to the use of names, people, trademarks, registered, unregistered or copyrighted designs or works of art or architecture depicted in any Image.
- 4.2. Where an Image is unreleased, The Licensee acknowledges that some jurisdictions provide legal protection against a person's image, likeness or property being used for commercial purposes without their consent and The Licensee shall be solely responsible for determining whether a release is required in connection with any proposed use of the Image.

5. Warranty and limitation of liability

- 5.1. DesignBase guarantees that should any Image have defects in material or workmanship and these are notified in writing to DesignBase within 30 of delivery then DesignBase will either replace the Image with another copy of the Image free from defect or refund the License Fee paid to the extent attributable to the defective Image. The decision to replace or refund will be made at DesignBase's sole discretion.
- 5.2. The Licensee should ensure that Image(s) are examined for possible defects (whether digital or otherwise) before sending the Image(s) for Reproduction. DesignBase shall not be liable for any loss or damage suffered by The Licensee or any third party arising from any alleged or actual defect in any Image or in any way from its Reproduction.
- 5.3. **DESIGNBASE MAKES NO OTHER WARRANTY, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, INCLUDING WITHOUT LIMITATION, ANY IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE. DESIGNBASE SHALL NOT BE LIABLE TO THE LICENSEE OR ANY OTHER PERSON OR ENTITY FOR ANY LOSS OF PROFIT OR ANY INDIRECT, SPECIAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL LOSS, DAMAGE, COSTS, EXPENSES OR OTHER CLAIMS (WHETHER CAUSED BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF DESIGNBASE, ITS SERVANTS, AGENTS OR OTHERWISE) WHICH ARISES OUT OF OR IN CONNECTION WITH THIS AGREEMENT, EVEN IF DESIGNBASE HAS BEEN ADVISED OF THE POSSIBILITY OF SUCH DAMAGES, COSTS OR LOSSES. DESIGNBASE'S MAXIMUM LIABILITY ARISING OUT OF, OR IN CONNECTION WITH THE LICENSEE'S USE OF OR INABILITY TO USE THE IMAGE (WHETHER IN CONTRACT, TORT OR OTHERWISE) SHALL TO THE EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW, BE LIMITED TO THE LICENSE FEE PAID FOR THE RELEVANT IMAGE.**

6. Payment

No Reproduction of any Image is authorised until payment in full has been received by DesignBase. Any Reproduction by or on behalf of The Licensee prior to payment being received by DesignBase constitutes a breach of this Agreement which entitles DesignBase immediately to terminate this Agreement and further constitutes an infringement of copyright.

7. Interest on overdue invoices and reasonable recovery costs

- 7.1. Unless otherwise agreed by us in writing, all Invoices are payable within 30 days.
- 7.2. DesignBase reserves the right to charge interest on late payments in accordance with the Late Payment of Commercial Debts [Interest] Act 1998 as amended and supplemented by the Late Payment of Commercial Debts Regulations 2002.
- 7.3. Any alterations to this payment term shall be agreed in writing with DesignBase.

8. Indemnity

The Licensee agrees to indemnify and hold DesignBase harmless against any claims, damages, losses, expenses or costs, including legal costs, arising in any manner whatsoever from unauthorised use of any Image supplied to The Licensee by DesignBase or any other breach by The Licensee of any obligations under this Agreement.

9. Cancellation

You shall not be entitled to cancel an order for an Image once the order has been accepted in whole or in part except by prior arrangement with the DesignBase.

10. Security and provision of digital information

Due to the nature of the Internet, downtime and lost transmissions may occur as part of routine maintenance or for any other reason. You are advised to maintain a copy of your account status, a backup of the Image subject to clause 2.4 and details of Image(s) purchased.

11. Miscellaneous terms

- 11.1. The License will terminate immediately if The Licensee (i) commits any act of bankruptcy or commences any proceeding of winding up (other than for the purposes of amalgamation or reconstruction) or if an Administrator, Receiver or Liquidator is appointed for the whole or any part of the business of the client or (ii) fails to perform any of their obligations under the Agreement within 28 days of our giving notice to comply. In the event of termination, all rights granted by this License will immediately revert to DesignBase and any further exploitation of any Image shall constitute an infringement of copyright.
- 11.2. Should any provision in this Agreement be found illegal or unenforceable in any respect, the legality and enforceability of the remaining provisions shall not be affected.
- 11.3. No variation of any of these Terms shall be effective unless in writing and signed by DesignBase and The Licensee. No action of DesignBase, other than an express written waiver, may be construed as a waiver of any provision of this Agreement. In the event that DesignBase waives any specific part of this Agreement such fact does not mean that any other part is waived. In the event of any inconsistency between the Terms and the terms contained in any purchase order or other communication the terms of this Agreement shall prevail.
- 11.4. If DesignBase is required to enforce its rights as a result of any breach of these terms, whether legal proceedings are commenced or not, The Licensee agrees to indemnify DesignBase in respect of all reasonable legal fees and costs incurred by DesignBase in relation thereto.

12. Jurisdiction

This agreement its validity and effect shall be governed by English Law and the contracting parties shall submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English Courts in any dispute which may arise concerning the agreement.
